How to Disable the PDF Reader in Microsoft Edge

Windows 10 comes with the default browser, Microsoft Edge.. You must disable Microsoft Edge's built-in PDF viewer in order to switch to Adobe Reader to view PDF files in eRSS. You can only view PDF files in eRSS in Adobe Acrobat.

To disable the Microsoft Edge PDF viewer:

1. Go to Settings.



2. Go to **System>Default Apps** in Windows 10 Anniversary Update and below. In Windows 10 Creators Update, go to **Apps > Default** apps

3. Scroll down the page until you find the **.pdf** file extension on the left side. On the right side, select Microsoft Edge, then choose **PDF-XChange Viewer**. This will disable the Microsoft Edge PDF reader.
